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The attention of all the District Educational Officers and EO-DPOs, Samagra Shiksha in the State is invited to the references cited. Vide reference 2nd cited, orders were issued for implementation of the Adolescent Safety and Empowerment Programme in 658 PM SHRI High Schools and Higher Secondary Schools during 2026-27, through Girl Child Empowerment and Adolescent Safety Clubs (GCEASCs) and Grievance Boxes for both boys and girls. Vide ref.3rd cited, Rs.20,000/- per school has been sanctioned.

The revised implementation guidelines, specifying the budget breakup for Rs.20,000/- are detailed below:
