ORDER :

In pursuance of the orders issued in the reference 1st to 3rd cited, sanction is hereby accorded for an amount of Rs.79,40,000/- (Rupees Seventy-Nine Lakhs and Forty Thousand only) towards the implementation of the Spoken English Programme in 794 PM SHRI Schools @ Rs. 10,000/- to each schools during the year 2026-2027. The amount is sanction to the Principals / Head Masters and District Educational Officers in the State (in respective of schools which do not have DDO codes) for implementation of the programme.

The Headmasters / Principals PM SHRI schools concerned and the District Educational Officers in respective of PM SHRI Schools not having separate DDO codes, shall utilized the funds stickily for the purpose for which there sanctioned and shall adhere to the guidelines while incurring expenditure towards the implementation of Spoken English Programme.

The Headmasters / Principals concerned shall be held personally responsible for proper utilization of the funds, implementation and monitoring of the programme, maintenance of prescribed records and submission of utilization certificates within the time lines prescribed by the department, duly comply with all financial rules, guidelines, and instructions issued from time to time.

Further, the 417 Headmasters/Principals (Annexure-I) having DDO code shall submit expenditure reports along with supporting documents such as invoices / GST bills within the stipulated time to the concerned Treasury.

In respect of 377 Schools (Annexure-II) which do not have DDO Codes, the concerned District Educational Officers (DEOs) shall obtain all supporting documents from the respective PM SHRI School Headmasters/Principals and submit consolidated bills to the concerned District Treasury.

The State Finance Controller of this office is requested to make necessary arrangements for allocation of funds to the authorized SNA SPARSH accounts of the respective Headmasters/Principals (417 Schools) and District Educational Officers (377 Schools without DDO Codes), as per the Annexure enclosed, for a total amount of Rs.79,40,000/- (Rupees Seventy-Nine Lakhs and Forty Thousand only).

Guidelines for Spoken English Programme for Classes I to XII in PM SHRI Schools during 2026-2027

1. Objective

To develop listening, speaking, pronunciation, vocabulary, communication, and presentation skills among students of Classes 1–12 through activity-based and experience

2. Target Group

- **Primary Level:** Classes 1–5
- **Secondary Level:** Classes 6–10
- **Senior Secondary Level:** Classes 11–12

3. Programme Duration

- One academic year
- Minimum **2 Spoken English activity periods per week**
- Monthly school-level activities
- Quarterly assessment and review

Programme Components

A. Primary Level (Classes 1–5)

Learning Outcomes

Students will:

- Understand simple classroom English.
- Use basic greetings and expressions.
- Develop confidence in speaking simple sentences.
- Improve pronunciation and vocabulary.

5. Show and Tell
6. Role Play
7. Daily English Conversation Practice
8. Word of the Day

Expected Outcomes

- Ability to introduce themselves.

B. Secondary Level (Classes 6–10)

- Speak confidently in English.
- Participate in discussions and presentations.
- Improve fluency and pronunciation.
- Use English for academic communication.

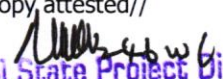
