Ref:- Minutes of the Meeting of the PAB held on 17th April, 2026 to consider the AWP&B 2026-27 of Telangana Samagra Shiksha communicated vide Lr.F.No.9-16/2024-IS.19/SS.19, Dated: 11.05.2026 of the Under Secretary to the GOI, Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, New Delhi.

In order to strengthen the professional competencies of Special Educators and Inclusive Education Resource Persons (IERPs) and to provide a platform for sharing the latest trends, innovations, and best practices in Inclusive Education, all District Educational Officers are hereby directed to organize District Level Orientation Programmes for Special Educators and Inclusive Education Resource Persons during the academic year 2026-27.

The following guidelines shall be adhered to while conducting the programmes:

1. A total of **five (5) orientation programmes** shall be conducted during the Academic Year 2026-27.
2. One orientation programme shall be organized every month at the district level preferably on Saturdays, in convergence with the Complex Meetings of Subject Teachers, as per the schedule communicated by SCERT.
3. All Special Educators and Inclusive Education Resource Persons working under Samagra Shiksha shall participate in the programmes.
4. The Orientation programmes shall focus on following areas:
 - Latest trends and developments in special education.
 - Inclusive teaching-learning practices.
 - Assistive technologies and accessibility.
 - Classroom accommodations and adaptations.
 - Assessment and intervention strategies.
 - Government policies, schemes and guidelines relating to Children with Special Needs (CWSN).
 - Sharing of best practices and field experiences.
5. State-level and district-level resource persons possessing expertise in Special Education and rehabilitation services, and Inclusive practices may be engaged as resource persons.
6. Guest lectures by professionals, experts, and practitioners in the field of Special Education and allied services shall be arranged as part of the programme.
7. District Educational Officers shall ensure proper planning, coordination, conduct, documentation and reporting of the programmes.
8. Attendance records, photographs, proceedings, expenditure, particulars and training reports shall be maintained and submitted to the State Office periodically.
9. An amount of **Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only)** is hereby sanctioned to each district for conducting the orientation programmes.

10. The sanctioned funds may be utilized towards :

- Transportation allowance to participants.
- Procurement of training and resource materials.
- Stationery, printing and training aids.
- Refreshments, snacks and drinking water.
- Honorarium/TA, wherever admissible to resource persons as per norms.
- Any other essential expenditure directly connected with the conduct of the orientation programmes.

The **District Educational Officer** shall personally monitor the planning, implementation, expenditure, documentation, and reporting of all five orientation programmes and ensure their successful completion during the Academic Year **2026-27**. The DEOs shall ensure strict adherence to the prescribed financial norms, proper utilization of funds, maintenance of vouchers and supporting records, and compliance with audit and verification requirements.

The **Director, SCERT, Hyderabad**, shall prepare and communicate the schedule for the orientation programmes in convergence with the Complex Meetings of Subject Teachers and shall monitor the implementation of the programme at the State level.
