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ORDER : -

In pursuance of the orders issued in the references 1st & 2nd cited, sanction is hereby accorded for an amount of **Rs. 1,36,60,000/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty-Six Lakhs and Sixty Thousand only)** towards the **Career Guidance and Counselling of Students** in 683 PM SHRI Schools @ Rs.20,000/- to each student during the year 2026-2027. The amount is sanctioned to the Principals / Head Masters and District Educational Officers in the State (in respective of schools which do not have DDO codes) for implementation of the programme.

The Headmasters / Principals of PM SHRI schools concerned (417 schools) and the District Educational Officers in respect of PM SHRI Schools not having separate DDO codes (266 schools) shall utilize the funds stickily for the purpose for which they are sanctioned and shall adhere to the guidelines while incurring expenditure towards the implementation of the Programme. (Guidelines Enclosed) :

The Headmasters / Principals concerned shall be held personally responsible for proper utilization of funds, implementation and monitoring of the programme, maintenance of prescribed records and submission of utilization certificates with in the time lines prescribed by the department, duly complying with all financial rules, guidelines, and instructions issued from time to time.

Further, the **417** Headmasters/Principals (Annexure-I) having DDO code shall submit expenditure reports along with supporting documents such as invoices / GST bills within the stipulated time to the concerned Treasury.

In respect of **266** High Schools (Annexure-II) which do not have DDO Codes, the concerned District Educational Officers (DEOs) shall obtain all supporting documents from the respective PM SHRI School Headmasters / Principals and submit consolidated bills to the concerned District Treasury.

The State Finance Controller of this office is requested to make necessary arrangements for allocation of funds to the authorized SNA SPARSH accounts of the respective Headmasters/Principals (417 Schools) and District Educational Officers (266 Schools without DDO Codes) as per the Annexure enclosed, for a total amount of **Rs. 1,36,60,000/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty-Six Lakhs and Sixty Thousand only)**

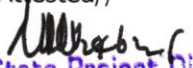
The guidelines shown in the annexure for implementation of Career Guidance and Counselling of Students shall be followed scrupulously without any deviation.

Schools may undertake the following activities such as,

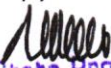
- Career Awareness Programmes for students.
- Career Counselling Sessions by experts, professionals and resource persons.
- Guidance on higher education opportunities, scholarships and entrance examinations.
- Psychometric and aptitude awareness sessions.
- Career talks by successful professionals, alumni and industry experts.
- Exposure visits to higher educational institutions, industries and skill development centres.
- Information dissemination on vocational education and skill development pathways.
- Conduct of career fairs, exhibitions and interactive sessions.
- Development of Career Information Corners in schools.
- Procurement of career guidance resource materials, brochures, charts and counselling aids.

The following guidelines shall be followed by the PMSHRI Headmasters/Principals in the State for utilization of Career Guidance and Counselling funds :

1. Activities shall be conducted with the objective of helping students make informed educational and career choices.
2. Schools shall organize career guidance programmes, counselling sessions and awareness activities for students.
3. Resource persons from higher education institutions, industries, government departments and professional organizations may be invited to interact with students.
4. Information regarding higher education opportunities, scholarships, vocational education, skill development programmes and competitive examinations shall be disseminated.
5. Career options / Course that can be chosen after SSC, Inter can be painted in prominent places in the school
6. Career Magazines, books can be subscribed
7. Schools may establish Career Information Corners containing career-related resource materials and information.
8. Career fairs, seminars and workshops may be organized for students.
9. Parents may be involved in career awareness and counselling programmes wherever feasible.
10. Proper records of activities conducted, expenditure incurred and student participation shall be maintained.
11. Photographs, reports, best practices and utilization particulars shall be documented and preserved for verification and submission to Samagra Shiksha, Telangana, as and when required.
12. The funds shall be utilized strictly for the purpose intended under Career Guidance and Counselling of Students intervention and in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Government of India and Samagra Shiksha from time to time.
