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ORDER:

The Government of India, Ministry of Education, Department of School Education & Literacy, in the Project Approval Board (PAB) approved the Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) 2026-27 under PM SHRI Scheme for Telangana covering 794 PM SHRI Schools in the State.

In the Recommendation Details Report for the year 2026-27 under Major Component: Curriculum, Pedagogy and Assessment, Sub Component: Sports & Physical Education, the following intervention has been approved:

The objective of the intervention is to strengthen sports infrastructure in PM SHRI Schools and promote physical fitness, discipline, teamwork, leadership qualities and sportsmanship among students through participation in sports and games activities.

The funds shall be utilized exclusively for procurement of Sports Equipment including Cricket Kits, Footballs, Volleyballs, Basketballs, Badminton Kits, Kho-Kho Equipment, Kabaddi Equipment, Athletics Equipment, Chess Boards, Carrom Boards, Fitness and Training Equipment, Medals, Trophies and Certificates required for sports activities and competitions.

The intervention will facilitate participation of students in sports competitions conducted at School, Mandal, District, State and National levels and support conduct of sports activities during National Festivals such as Independence Day, Republic Day and other Government-sponsored programmes.

An amount of Rs.50,000/- per PM SHRI School is being released to the District Educational Officer (DEO) concerned, district-wise, for procurement of Sports Equipment or

laying of sports courts through Engineering Wings at the Dist. Level to the PMSHRI Schools in their Jurisdiction.

The DEO concerned shall place the proposal before the District Collector, Chairman, District Project Committee (DPC) for finalization of the items to be procured through e-tenders and sports courts works to be taken up through the Govt. Engineering Depts.

The DPC may finalize the works to be taken /Sports material to be procured up after due consultation with the SGF Secretaries and School Assistant (Physical Education) concerned, and after analysing the local requirement of the PM SHRI Schools in the district.

The DEO shall thereafter incur the expenditure by presenting the bills in the District Treasury and ensure that the amounts are credited to the accounts of the Vendors / agencies (or) third parties etc.

All the District Educational Officers shall ensure that Invoices, GST Bills / Purchase Bills and other supporting documents pertaining to the PM SHRI Schools in their jurisdiction are obtained and consolidated expenditure reports are submitted in the District Treasury within the stipulated deadline.

Therefore, sanction is hereby accorded for release of an amount of **Rs.3,97,00,000/- (Rupees Three Crores Ninety Seven Lakhs only)** to the District Educational Officers concerned, district-wise, @ **Rs.50,000/- per school** for 794 PM SHRI Schools in the State, towards implementation of C62 – Sports Equipment (Recurring) under PM SHRI Scheme, as per the district-wise allocation statement placed at **Annexure-I**, for procurement of sports items to the PM SHRI Schools of their jurisdiction, after finalization of the works/items by the District Collector, Chairman, DPC.

The State Finance Controller of this office is requested to release the Budget to the District Educational Officers concerned as per the district-wise allocation statement placed at Annexure-I, for a total amount of Rs.3,97,00,000/- (Rupees Three Crores Ninety Seven Lakhs only).

The expenditure shall be met from the budget provision approved under: Major Component: Curriculum, Pedagogy and Assessment – Sub Component: Sports & Physical Education – Activity: Sports and Physical Education (R) – Sub Activity: C 62: Sports Equipment (R) in 794 PM SHRI Schools under the following Head of Account:

The District Educational Officers concerned shall ensure that the funds are utilized strictly for the purpose for which they are sanctioned and in accordance with the guidelines annexed to these proceedings, after finalization of works/items by the District Collector, Chairman, DPC in consultation with the SGF Secretaries and School Assistant (Physical Education) concerned.

The Headmasters of PM SHRI Schools shall maintain stock registers, bills, vouchers, photographs and utilization records for audit and verification purposes. Utilization Certificates along with expenditure statements and photographs shall be submitted to the concerned District Educational Officers within the prescribed time.

The District Educational Officers shall communicate these proceedings along with guidelines to all concerned Mandal Educational Officers and Headmasters / Complex Headmasters of PM SHRI Schools immediately.

GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF C62 – SPORTS EQUIPMENT
(RECURRING) IN 794 PM SHRI SCHOOLS

(Enclosure for Proc Rc.No 6064//SS/PLG/PMSHRI/2026

Dated: -11-07-2026)

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Sports and Physical Education play a vital role in the holistic development of students by promoting physical fitness, mental well-being, teamwork, leadership, discipline and sportsmanship. Provision of Sports Equipment in PM SHRI Schools will encourage active participation in Sports and Games, facilitate talent identification, and nurture students sporting abilities.

All the District Educational officers and the Headmasters/Principals of PMSHRI Schools shall ensure the effective utilization of the sports equipment provided and organize regular sports and physical education activities. They shall encourage and facilitate student's participation in sports and games at the school, Mandal, District, and state Levels including competitions and events organised during National festivals and other significant occasions.

Objectives

- Promote physical fitness and healthy lifestyle among students.
- Encourage participation in sports and games at School, Mandal, District, State and National levels.
- Develop teamwork, leadership qualities, discipline and sportsmanship.
- Strengthen sports culture and physical education in PM SHRI Schools.
- Facilitate participation in competitions conducted during National Festivals and Government-sponsored events.
- Support holistic development and talent identification among students.

Implementation Guidelines:

1. The amount of Rs.50,000/- per PM SHRI School shall be utilized exclusively for Sports Equipment and sports-related activities, and shall be procured by the District Educational Officer (DEO) concerned for the PM SHRI Schools in their jurisdiction.
2. The works/items to be procured shall be finalized by the District Collector, Chairman, District Project Committee (DPC) concerned, in consultation with the SGF Secretaries and School Assistant (Physical Education) concerned.
3. The DPC shall analyse the local requirement of each PM SHRI School before finalizing the sports items to be procured.
4. Indoor and outdoor sports equipment shall be procured based on local requirements and student participation of each PM SHRI School.
5. Preference shall be given to durable, quality and student-friendly sports materials.
6. Students shall be encouraged to participate in sports competitions conducted at School, Mandal, District, State and National levels.
7. Sports activities may be organized during National Festivals such as Independence Day, Republic Day and other Government-sponsored programmes.
8. Medals, trophies, certificates and prizes may be procured to encourage student participation and recognize achievement in sports competitions.
9. Physical Education Teachers shall maintain a Sports Equipment Register indicating details of materials procured and utilized.
10. Schools shall organize regular sports and fitness activities throughout the academic year.
11. Inclusive participation of girls, boys and Children with Special Needs (CwSN) shall be ensured wherever feasible.
12. No expenditure shall be incurred on civil works or activities unrelated to sports and physical education.
13. Procurement shall be made following prescribed financial norms ensuring transparency, economy and accountability.
14. Bills, vouchers, stock registers and expenditure records shall be maintained for audit and verification.

15. Photographs and reports of sports activities and competitions shall be maintained at school level.
16. Utilization Certificate along with expenditure statement and photographs shall be submitted by the District Educational Officer concerned to the State Project Director.

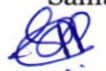
