ORDER:

Government of India, Ministry of Education, under the PM SHRI Scheme, has approved the intervention "Enhancement of School Facilities & Beautification" under the component Strengthening of Existing Schools in the Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) 2026-27 for 109 PM SHRI Primary Schools in Telangana State with a financial norm of Rs.1 Lakh per school, involving a total financial outlay of ₹109.00 Lakhs.

In order to ensure uniformity, transparency and quality in implementation of the programme across all the selected (109) PM SHRI Primary Schools, the Implementation Guidelines appended to these proceedings as Annexure are hereby communicated.

The District Educational Officers-cum-Ex-Officio District Project Officers, Samagra Shiksha, shall ensure that:

- The funds are utilized strictly for the purpose for which they are sanctioned.
- A School Enhancement & Beautification Plan is prepared by the Amma Adarsha Patashala Committees (AAPC) based on the actual requirements of the school before commencement of the works.
- The activities are taken up strictly in accordance with the guidelines appended to these proceedings.
- Procurement of materials and execution of works are carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Samagra Shiksha Financial Management Guidelines and Government financial rules in force.
- The works are executed with due regard to quality, safety, child-friendly design, inclusiveness and environmental sustainability.

The District Educational Officers and Ex-Officio District Project Officers, Samagra Shiksha, in the State shall closely monitor the implementation of the programme and ensure timely completion of all activities in accordance with the approved guidelines.

Any deviation from these guidelines or misuse/diversion of funds shall be viewed seriously and responsibility shall be fixed on the concerned officials in accordance with the rules in force.

Implementation Guidelines for Enhancement of School Facilities & Beautification in 109 PM SHRI Primary Schools

The intervention aims to create safe, child-friendly, inclusive and aesthetically appealing school environments by improving the physical ambience of PM SHRI Primary Schools, thereby promoting Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN), joyful learning and the holistic development of children.

Financial assistance under this intervention shall be limited to Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) per school. The expenditure incurred shall not exceed the approved allocation.

Amma Adarsha Patashala Committee (AAPC) of respective school shall prepare a School Enhancement and Beautification Plan, based on the specific requirements of the school, before commencement of the activities. Priority shall be accorded to activities that directly improve the learning environment and support the educational needs of children studying in Classes I to V.

The following activities may be taken up, subject to the actual requirements of the school and within the approved financial ceiling:

a. School Entrance & Campus Identity:

- Development of attractive entrance with school name board and PM SHRI branding.
- Theme-based murals promoting environmental awareness, cleanliness, health, sports and national values.
- Educational wall paintings depicting alphabets, numbers, multiplication tables, science concepts, maps, inspirational quotations and local culture.
- Inspirational messages suitable for primary school children.

b. Child-Friendly Learning Spaces:

- Activity corners for FLN.
- Reading corners and storytelling spaces.
- Learning circles and outdoor learning spaces.
- Floor paintings for educational games.
- Play-based learning markings.

c. Foundational Learning Spaces:

- Display Space for Models developed using TLM.
- Display boards showcasing students' achievements.

d. Activity-Based Learning Areas:

- Alphabet Pathways.
- Number Pathways.
- Educational Floor Games.
- Counting Games.

- Shape Recognition Activities.
- Outdoor Learning Circles.
- Joyful Learning Spaces.
- Graph Model Chalkboard

e. Campus Beautification:

- Landscaping with flowering plants.
- Herbal Garden.
- Kitchen Garden.
- Improvement of pathways.
- Tree Plantation.
- Dustbins for waste segregation.

f. Classroom Beautification:

- Child-friendly paintings, classroom decoration.
- Educational displays.
- Learning charts.
- Motivational messages.
- Attendance and classroom information boards.

g. Assembly Area:

- Beautification of Assembly Area.
- School Pledge Board.
- National Anthem Display.
- Inspirational Quotations.

h. Child Safety & Health Awareness:

- Drinking Water Signage.
- Toilet Signage.
- Hand Washing Instructions.
- First Aid Signage.
- Emergency Exit Signage.
- Safety Signage.

i. Inclusive School Environment:

- Child-friendly directional signage.
- Inclusive signboards.
- Gender Equality Messages.
- Kindness and Respect Messages

j. Procurement & Financial Management:

- Procurement shall be carried out in accordance with the Samagra Shiksha Financial Management Guidelines and Government financial rules.
- Transparency shall be maintained in procurement.
- Proper quotations, bills and vouchers shall be maintained wherever applicable.
- Assets created shall be entered in the Stock Register and Asset Register.

k. **Quality Standards:** The works shall ensure Child-friendly design, Safety of children, Inclusive accessibility, Eco-friendly and durable materials, Quality workmanship and Attractive and colourful learning environment.

l. **Activities Not Permitted:**

The funds shall not be utilized for:

- Construction of new buildings.
- Major civil works.
- Repairs already covered under any other scheme.
- Purchase of furniture, computers or electronic equipment.
- Payment of salaries or honorarium.
- Recurring expenditure.

Any activity not related to school enhancement and beautification

m. **General Instructions:**

- Funds shall be utilized exclusively for the approved purpose.
- No expenditure shall exceed the approved ceiling of ₹1.00 lakh per school.
- Preference shall be given to child-friendly, colourful, durable and eco-friendly materials.
- Each school shall maintain SMC Resolution, School Enhancement & Beautification Plan, Estimates, Bills and Vouchers, Stock Register, Asset Register, Photographs (Before, During and After execution), Completion Certificate and Utilization Certificate.
- Community participation may be encouraged for plantation, mural painting and campus development without any additional financial liability to Government.
- The District Educational Officers shall ensure strict compliance with these guidelines and submit completion reports to the State Project Office.
